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**NEW “1933 LOUNGE” OPENS AT ST. ELMO STEAK HOUSE  
Space Pays Tribute to the End of Prohibition and Iconic Nature of Restaurant**

Indianapolis – Guests can now enjoy a true extension of the historic nature of St. Elmo Steak House, on the second floor of the restaurant, in the new 1933 Lounge. The space adds 60 seats in addition to an adjoining private dining room.

Celebrating the end of prohibition, the space showcases dark woods and deep colors, two antique fireplaces and the main focal point is a restored vintage bar dating back to 1898. The bar from Assumption, Illinois, was made by Brunswick – the same company that made the bar on the first floor of St. Elmo – known at the time for making fine billiard tables but expanded to a line of bars including carved wooden back bars. Today, Brunswick is best known for its bowling products.

“St. Elmo’s Main Bar is the first and last area our guests see during a dinner visit to the steakhouse, said Craig Huse, co-proprietor of St. Elmo Steak House. Its energetic and historic atmosphere defines the restaurant. However, the new 2<sup>nd</sup> floor 1933 Lounge provides guests with a bar experience conducive for relaxed conversation while enjoying appetizers and classic cocktails.”

The menu features a variety of classic and new appetizers including the world-famous St. Elmo Shrimp Cocktail, fried mac ‘n cheese infused with applewood-smoked bacon, sliced NY strip steak, sesame seared sashimi tuna, beef carpaccio, and desserts. In addition to food items, St. Elmo has added numerous twists to classic cocktails including the new Signature “Elmo Cola” prepared with Maker’s Mark Bourbon infused with Italian Luxardo Maraschino Cherries and Madagascar vanilla beans served with an ice-cold glass bottle of Coca Cola.

The 1933 Lounge is open Monday – Saturday from 5 p.m. – midnight and Colts home game Sundays.

St. Elmo Steak House, an independent restaurant, has been a landmark in downtown Indianapolis since 1902.
